### What is this Assignment About?

What are you about to learn? You will learn how to prepare properly for an international mobility by following a step-by-step path.

To achieve this assignment you are required to provide evidence to demonstrate your knowledge and understanding of how to prepare for **mobility**.

A good preparation helps you to make your stay abroad successful. If you go abroad, you have to think about a lot of things. Through the completion of this assignment you should find the necessary information and take the right steps so that you can start well with the international training and/or internship.

The assignment tasks are detailed below. Level 3 has a different set of tasks from level 4 and 5.

### Assignment Task/s

**1. Orientation on student mobility:**

- a. What do you expect from going abroad?

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b. What do you expect to learn?

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c. What do you expect to see?

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d. Would you like to develop your knowledge of another culture?

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e. Do you think that you are independent enough to actually stay in a foreign country alone?

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f. What skills and competences will you require to manage the mobility?

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g. What skills and competences do you need to improve?

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**2. During the mobility – expectations, routines etc:**

a. What is expected of you from the receiving school?

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b. How do you report if you get sick?

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c. What do you need to bring with you?

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**3. Arrange formalities:**

a. Your learning agreement

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b. Valid identity document

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c. Travel

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d. Insurance (healthcare, travel, e.g.)

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e. Collect the information that you need to take with you (school, home, brochures, pictures e.g.)

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f. Prepare a presentation about yourself, your school and country

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**4. Financial plan:**

a. Are you getting any money that will support this mobility experience?

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b. How much money do you need?

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c. Do you have a valid and accepted credit card?

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5. **Travel:** Itinerary of your outgoing and incoming travel – when will you leave and return and from where and how?

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 6. **Communication:** How are you going to stay in touch with your school and/or family?  
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7. **Professional language**

- a. List and learn 40 words connected with your professional field in English.
- b. List and learn 10 phrases connected with your professional field in English.

8. **Take care of all the documents:** Bring your learning agreement to the mobility. You'll receive a Europass Mobility certificate at the end of the mobility. Take care of it and bring it with you back home.

**Minimum Evidence Required to Gain an Approval for Mobility**

Present a folder that covers all of the tasks with the outcomes of this assignment.
